Whilst confirming the decision of the Disciplinary Committee, the Council observed that in facts and circumstances of this case, the interest of justice will be served, if a warning is issued to Dr. Vishesh Jain, Dr. Sandeep Agarwala, Dr. Saumya Jagannath, Dr. Shalimar and Dr. Anoop Sarya; hence, the Council directs that a warning be issued to Dr. Vishesh Jain(Delhi Medical Council Registration No.DMC/R/1254), Dr. Sandeep Agarwala (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.10392), Dr. Saumya Jagannath Mahapatra (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.DMC/R/7225), Dr. Shalimar (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.DMC/R/00185) and Dr. Anoop Saraya (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.7646). Further, a copy of this Order be also sent to the Directorate General of Health Services, Govt. of India and the Secretary, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India for taking note of the observations made in the Order of the Disciplinary Committee and initiate necessary remedial measures, for future.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed..

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 60 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

- (xlii) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2370-a representation from Police Station Jama Masjid, Delhi seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Shri Yogesh Sharma r/o H. No. 2008, Shri Radha Krishna Mandir, Bazar Sitaram, Delhi, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Kasturba Hospital, New Delhi-110002, in the treatment of complainant's wife Smt. Pooja Sharma, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of removal of name of Dr. Ramanjeet Kaur (Delhi Medical Council Registration No. 25780) and Dr. Shobhika Singh (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.DMC/R/13968) for a period of 30 days awarded by the Disciplinary Committee.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 60 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

Kumar), Khusgar Clinic, B-56, Gali No.1, Sri Ram Colony, Rajeev Nagar, Khajoori, Delhi-110094 who is an unqualified medical person in flagrant violation of the Regulation 1.6 of Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics) Regulation, 2002, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

(xliv) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2167 of Shri Jai Prakash Chauhan, S/o Lt. Chandra Singh, R/o T-58A Nangli Razapur, Sarai Kale Khan, New Delhi-110013, forwarded by the Directorate General of Health Service, Govt. of NCT. of Delhi, alleging medical negligence on the part of the doctors of Jeewan Hospital, 150, Jeewan Nagar, Opp. Maharani Bagh, New Delhi-110014, in the treatment of the complainant's nephew Shri Vipin Chauhan, resulting in his death 06.07.2017, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council further confirmed the punishment of warning awarded by the Disciplinary Committee to Dr. Rajeev Om Prakash (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.3672) with a direction that he should undergo 12 hours of Continuing Medical Education (C.M.E.) on the subject related to 'Hepato-Biliary Surgery'" within a period of three months from the date of the Order and submit a compliance report to this effect to the Delhi Medical Council.

As per the minutes of the Council dated 29th April, 2022, the Council observed that the matter be referred back to the Disciplinary Committee for re-consideration on the issue that in light of fetal distress, whether performing of L.S.C.S. was not warranted, even, if the patient had Hb. of 05.08 and blood was being asked to be arranged.

The subsequent Order dated 29th July, 2022 of the Disciplinary Committee after re-consideration, was placed before the Council today i.e. 10th August, 2022 for confirmation.

The Council after due deliberations, confirmed the Orders dated 27th April, 2022 and 29th July, 2022 of the Disciplinary Committee.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of warning awarded to Dr. Seema Pandey(Delhi Medical Council Registration No.15286) and Dr. Vipin Chandra Pandey (Delhi Medical Council 13498). The Council further directed that Dr. Seema Pandey and Dr. Vipin Chandra Pandey shall undergo twelve hours of Continuing Medical Education (C.M.E.) on the subject "Labour Management" within a period of three months from the date of the Order and submit a compliance report to this effect to the Delhi Medical Council.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

Sushila Devi, r/o- 237, Defence Colony Hisar, forwarded by the Directorate General of Health Services, Govt. of NCT. of Delhi, alleging medical negligence and professional misconduct on the part of doctors of Max Super Specialty Hospital , FC-50, C&D Block, Shalimar Bagh, New Delhi- 110088, in the treatment of complainant's son Mr. Krishi, resulting in his death on 29.04.2017, was determined by the Disciplinary Committee vide Order dated 08th April, 2022. The Order dated 08th April, 2022 of the Disciplinary Committee was put up to the Delhi Medical Council for confirmation in its meeting held on 29th April, 2022. As per the minutes of the Council dated 29th April, 2022, the Council observed that since in this case, the forensic expert had not participated in the Disciplinary Committee proceedings, the Order be reverted back to the Disciplinary Committee with request to deliberate the same in consultation with a forensic expert.

The subsequent Order dated 29th July, 2022 of the Disciplinary Committee after re-consideration, was placed before the Council today i.e. 10th August, 2022 for confirmation.

The Council after due deliberations, confirmed the Orders dated 08th April, 2022 and 29th July, 2022 of the Disciplinary Committee.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

- (li) A complainant No. 2500-a representation from Dy. Commissioner of Police, Central District, Delhi, seeking medical opinion in respect of death of Sh. Surat Singh, allegedly due to medical negligence in the treatment administered to deceased at BL Kapur Hospital, Pusa Road, Delhi, was determined by the Disciplinary Committee vide Order dated 29th March, 2022. The Order dated 29th March, 2022 of the Disciplinary Committee was put up to the Delhi Medical Council for confirmation in its meeting held on 29th April, 2022. As per the

minutes of the Council dated 29th April, 2022, the Council observed the matter be referred back to the Disciplinary Committee for re-consideration by observing *“that as per records, the patient who had earlier undergone PTCA to LAD on 27th March, 2018 at Saroj Hospital and subsequently had to be readmitted on 01st April, 2018 with shortness of breathlessness and hypotension at Saroj Hospital; presented to B.L. Kapur Hospital on 06th April, 2018 with complaints of breathlessness and orthopnea, on investigations, ECG - qRBBB, Troponin T was significantly high 3760 pg/ml (normal range < 34.0 pg/ml), NT pro BNP 16067 pg/ml (normal range < 376 pg/ml), ECHO suggestive of worsening mitral regurgitation possibly ischemic; under these medical condition, can the possibility of re-myocardial infarction having occurred in the patient, be completely ruled out? Further, CAG reported on 07th April, 2018 revealed critical LCX and RCA lesion and the doctor having arrived at diagnosis of Acute Left Ventricular Failure, clinically, the decision to subject the patient to PTCA to LCX and RCA, under consent, after having discussed the alternative in form of medical management, as is evident from the Consent Form, to alleviate the condition of the patient; was it not within the clinical judgment of the treating cardiologist?”*

The subsequent Order dated 29th July, 2022 of the Disciplinary Committee after re-consideration, was placed before the Council today i.e. 10th August, 2022 for confirmation.

The Council after due deliberations, confirmed the Orders dated 29th March, 2022 and 29th July, 2022 of the Disciplinary Committee.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

4. To discuss about the Minutes of the Anti Quackery Committee.

The minutes of the meeting of the Anti-Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council held on 02nd June, 2022 (appended herewith as annexure 'B') which were circulated to the members present, were confirmed.

5. To discuss about the Minutes of the Finance Committee.

The minutes of the meeting of the Finance Committee of the Delhi Medical Council held on 07th July, 2022 (appended herewith as annexure 'C') which were circulated to the members present, were confirmed except item No.02 (Hiring of Vehicle).

The Council members deliberated and decided that the vehicle should be in good condition with registration not before 2022 and fresh quotations for hiring of vehicles for official purposes may be invited.

6. To discuss about the representation received from Indian Association of Dermatologists, Verereologists and Leprologists 2022 dated 31.05.2022.

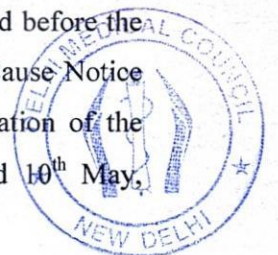

- 1) **Shri Bishamber Kumar :-** Shri Bishamber Kumar appeared before the Anti-Quackery Committee and submitted a reply. The reply submitted by Shri Bishamber Kumar was found to be unsatisfactory in response to Show Cause Notice No.DMC/AQ/F.3-A/SCNs/2/2022/306108 dated 25th May, 2022. On examination of the inspection report no. F.12(3)/CMDO/SWD/DHS/AQ/06/pt-XII/772 dated 18th May, 2022 was received from the office of the CDMO(South West District), in respect of Shri Bishamber Kumar the Anti Quackery Committee noted that Shri Bishamber Kumar has been practicing allopathy without holding any requisite medical qualification as enumerated in the Schedules I, II, III of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, entitling him to practice in allopathy and also not being registered with the Delhi Medical Council, in violation of the Section 15(6) of the Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997.

In light of the above, the Anti Quackery Committee, hereby, in exercise of powers conferred under section 10(h) of the Delhi Medical Council, Act, 1997 recommends that Shri Bishamber Kumar be directed to stop practicing allopathy, forthwith, and to close down his clinic and Anti Quackery Committee also decided that the police be requested to register a FIR under Section 27 of Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997 alongwith relevant Section of IPC.

- 2) **Shri Rajbir Singh Nagar:-** Shri Rajbir Singh Nagar neither replied nor appeared before the Anti-Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council in response to Show Cause Notice No.DMC/AQ/F.3-A/SCNs/2/ 2022/306106 dated 25th May, 2022. On examination of the inspection report no. F.23/Comp./192/SED/DGHS/NHC//2021-2022/1960 dated 10th May,



2022 received from the office of the CDMO (South East District), in respect of Shri Rajbir Singh Nagar, the Anti Quackery Committee noted that Shri Rajbir Singh Nagar has been practicing allopathic system of medicine without holding any requisite medical qualification as enumerated in the Schedules I, II, III of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, entitling him to practice in allopathy and also not being registered with the Delhi Medical Council, in violation of the Section 15(6) of the Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997.

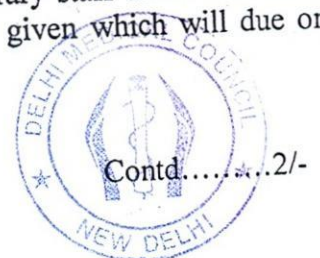

Minutes of the Finance Committee Meeting of the Council held on 07/07/2022 in the Office of the Delhi Medical Council at 03.00 PM.

1. The rates of Interest of different banks on F.D.R's of Rs. 4 crores were presented before the finance Committee of the Council and are enclosed herewith. The Finance Committee decided that a single FDR amounting to Rs.4 crores may be made with PNB Housing Finance Limited for a period of 5 years @ 7.25% per annum (Tentative yield on Maturity is 8.38%) as Interest rates offered by PNB Housing Finance Limited are maximum.
2. The govt. rules regarding payment of Earned Leaves were presented before the Finance Committee of the Council according to which 300 days Earned leaves are to be paid at the time of retirement of the employee. The payment made to LIC Group leave encashment policy amounting to Rs.4,01,839/- on 29/03/2022 was also shown to the Finance Committee of the Council. Earlier the Finance Committee of the Council approved the payment of Surplus Earned leaves beyond 300 Earned leaves to the eligible permanent employees of the Council for smooth and efficient functioning of the Council's work but now the Finance Committee decided that no payment of surplus Earned leaves beyond 300 Earned leaves (as per govt. rules) should be made to the eligible permanent employees of the Council.
3. Salary paid to all the six temporary staff of the Council along with letter submitted by all the six temporary staff regarding 10% contribution from employee side and 10% contribution along with administrative charges from employer side were presented before the Finance Committee of the Council and are enclosed herewith. The Finance Committee decided that all the six temporary staff of the Council may be covered under Provident Fund with EPFO. The Finance Committee also decided that 10% contribution should be deducted from the salary of all the six temporary staff and 10% contribution along with administrative charges should be paid by the Council. The Finance Committee also decided that the contribution for Provident fund should be deducted on basic pay of all the six temporary staff of the Council which shall be 60% of their total monthly salary (40% presumed to be allowances). The Finance Committee also decided that due to coverage of all the six temporary staff under Provident Fund, no annual Increment to all the six temporary staff will be given which will due on November, 2022.



4. The company Profile along with quotation for PF service offered by M/s SGC Management Services Private Ltd was shown to the Finance Committee of the Council and are enclosed herewith. The Finance committee decided that as the work relating to day to day PF is already being done by the staff of the Council, so there is no need of hiring PF consultant which is charging Rs.5,500/- per month plus GST. The Finance Committee also decided that the services of PF consultant can be taken as and when required but not on monthly basis.
5. The details regarding the Security amount which was deducted from the Final payment of the Contractor of new office was shown to the Finance Committee and are enclosed herewith. The finance Committee decided that Security amount may be released to the Contactor after completing all the pending repair works. The Finance committee also decided that the Architect firm which was hired for renovation work of new office should give a letter regarding release of the Security amount.
