The following agenda was discussed:-

1. Minutes of the meeting held on 06th January, 2021.

The minutes of the Council meeting held on 06th January, 2021 were circulated to all the members present, for information.

However, in regard to agenda No.3 relating to constitution of various Committee/Sub-Committee of the Council, Dr. Rakesh Kumar Gupta contended that even though, the President had been authorized to constitute the Committee/Sub-Committee for carrying the functions of the Council, it is desired that the President consult the members, in this regard.

The President informed that the process of the constitution of the Committee/Sub-Committee for carrying the functions of the Council is still in process, although, few of the Committees have been constituted and he had consulted with the concerned members. However, if some members want to volunteer themselves, they may do so, and he shall make an endeavour to accommodate them in the Committees which are yet to be constituted.

Dr. Prem Kumar Aggarwal requested the President to consider his name for the Finance Committee.

Similarly, Dr. Harish Gupta in regard to point 1 of agenda No.4 relating to any other item with permission of Chair, contended that the issue of nomination of one member amongst the elected members of the Delhi Medical Council in Medical Advisory Council in the National Medical Commission should not have been taken under any other item but should have been taken in main agenda item.

The President stated that since the majority of the members present agreed with taking-up the said issue; hence, the same was allowed.

2. Action taken report of minutes of the meeting held on 06th January, 2021.

3. To discuss cases of medical negligence and unethical conduct.

- (a) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No. 2837-B-a reference from the Directorate General of Health Services, seeking investigation into a complaint dated 6.10.2015 of Shri Radhakanta Tripathy made to National Human Rights Commission, alleging medical negligence in the treatment of patient Master Avinash who died on 8.9.2015 allegedly due to medical negligence on the part of Aakash Hospital, Saket City Hospital, Sama Hospital, Moolchand Hospital, Irene Hospital, Batra Hospital, Madan Mohan Malviya Hospital, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (b) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No. 3043 of Smt. Palak Sugandh w/o Shri Pulkit Sugandh r/o WZ-1755 IInd Floor, Multani Mohalla Rani Bagh, Delhi-110034, alleging medical negligence in the treatment of complainant at Medha Hospital K.P. Block, Pitampura, Delhi-110034, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (c) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2989 of Shri Indra Prakash Singh Raghuvanshi, Raghuvanshi Niketan, Adjacent Adya Katyayani Shakti Peeth Mandir, Chattarpur, New Delhi-110074, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors Fortis Ft. Lt. Ranjan Dhall Hospital, Sector B, Pocket-1, Aruna Asaf Ali Marg, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi-110070, in the treatment administered to the complainant's wife Smt. Sangeeta Raghuvanshi, resulting in her death on 09.04.2019, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

Malti Devi r/o K-567, Mangol Puri, New Delhi-110083, forwarded by Public Grievance Monitoring System, alleging professional misconduct on the part of doctors of Sanjay Gandhi Memorial Hospital, in the treatment of complainant's mother Smt. Malti Devi, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

- (e) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3106, of Shri Hari Gopal, r/o- House No. 216, Khasra No.50/14, Khera Kalaa Colony, Delhi-110082 , alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Dinesh Bansal, Ishan Hospital, Plot No.01, Pocket-8B, Sector-19, Rohini, Delhi-110089, in the treatment administered to the complainant's son Master Vaibhav Kumar, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of warning awarded by the Disciplinary Committee to Dr. Prasansa Garewal (Dr. Prasansha Garewal, Delhi Medical Council Registration No. 10000).

The Council also confirmed the punishment of warning awarded by the Disciplinary Committee to Dr. Abhilasha Garg (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.9453).

- (v) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No. 2224- a representation from Police, forwarded by the Medical Council of India, seeking medical opinion in respect

of death of Smt. Kawaljeet Kaur allegedly (referred hereinafter as the patient), due to medical negligence in the treatment administered to Smt. Kawaljeet Kaur at Mai Kamli Wali Hospital, J-Block, Rajouri Garden, Delhi, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

4. To nominate one member in Medical Advisory Council of the National Medical Commission amongst the elected members of the newly constituted Delhi Medical Council.

Since there was no consensus on any one member, it was decided to hold the election through secret ballot.

Dr. Harish Gupta and Dr. Ashwani Goyal raised their objection regarding this agenda item and abstain from participating in the election of one member in Medical Advisory Council of the National Medical Commission amongst the elected members of the newly constituted Delhi Medical Council.

Dr. Rajiv Sood, Dr. Manish Narang and Dr. Rakesh Kumar Gupta proposed their respective name for nomination to Medical Advisory Council under Clause 11(1)(e) of National Medical Commission, 2019.

There were three contesting candidates – Dr. Rajiv Sood, Dr. Manish Narang and Dr. Rakesh Kumar Gupta.

Elections were held through secret ballot.

Dr. Rajiv Sood was declared elected as one member amongst the elected members of the Delhi Medical Council in Medical Advisory Council in the National Medical Commission.

The President informed that outcome of this Election, is subject to the court decision which is to be pronounced in W.P.(C) No.6776/2021 & CM APPL. 21354/2021 matter titled 'Dr. Harish Gupta Versus U.O.I. & Others.

5. Any other item with permission of Chair.

- (a) The minutes of the meeting of the Anti-Quackery of the Delhi Medical Council held on 03rd February, 2021 (**appended herewith as annexure 'B'**) which were circulated to the members present, were confirmed.
- (b) The minutes of the meeting of the Finance Committee of the Delhi Medical Council held on 16th July, 2021 (**appended herewith as annexure 'C'**) which were circulated to the members present, were confirmed.
- (c) The minutes of the meeting of the Land & Building Committee of the Delhi Medical Council held on 19th July, 2021 (**appended herewith as annexure 'D'**) which were circulated to the members present, were confirmed.
- (d) Dr. Prem Kumar Aggarwal stated that the decision of the Executive Committee/Disciplinary Committee of the Delhi Medical Council in complaints of medical negligence/professional misconduct against a registered medical practitioner should be made available in advance to the members, so that they may get themselves apprise of the facts of the case, before the confirming the decision.

The President informed that the decisions cannot be made available in advance to preserve the confidentiality, however, any member, if he/she desires; can visit the office of the Delhi Medical Council, three days prior to the scheduled Council meeting and examine all the complaint files in regard to which, the decision of the Executive Committee/Disciplinary Committee are to be taken up for confirmation in the Council meeting.

Prem Kumar Aggarwal further contended that since the Executive Committee derives its power from the Council; he be informed about of the powers / function of the Executive Committee.

The President informed that the powers, duties and functions of the Executive Committee are laid in Delhi Medical Council Act and Rules made thereunder.

The President further informed that in terms of the provisions of the Section 21(2), the Executive Committee is empowered to examine the complaints of medical negligence/professional misconduct.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.

1. **Shri D.K Biswas:-** Shri D.K Biswas appeared before the Anti-Quackery Committee and submitted a reply. The reply submitted by Shri D.K Biswas was found to be unsatisfactory in response to Show Cause Notice No.DMC/AQ/F.3-A/SCNs/2/2021/294232 dated 22nd January, 2021. On examination of the inspection report no. File No: F.1/17/(Part XXIX/2001/DHS/NWD/AQ/5135-36 dated 01st July, 2020 received from the office of the CDMO(North West District), in respect of Shri D.K Biswas the Anti Quackery Committee noted that Shri D.K Biswas has been practicing allopathy without holding any requisite medical qualification as enumerated in the Schedules I, II, III of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, entitling him to practice in allopathy and also not being registered with the Delhi Medical Council, in violation of the Section 15(6) of the Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997.

In light of the above, the Anti Quackery Committee, hereby, in exercise of powers conferred under section 10(h) of the Delhi Medical Council, Act, 1997 recommends that Shri D.K Biswas be directed to stop practicing allopathy, forthwith, and to close down his clinic and Anti Quackery Committee also decided that the police be requested to register a FIR under Section 27 of Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997 alongwith relevant Section of IPC.



2. **Shri Sanjay Singh:-** Shri Sanjay Singh appeared before the Anti-Quackery Committee and submitted a reply. The reply submitted by Shri Sanjay Singh was found to be unsatisfactory in response to Show Cause Notice No.DMC/AQ/F.3-A/SCNs/2/2021/294233 dated 22nd January, 2021. On examination of the inspection report no. File No: F.20(1)/Antiquackery/DHS/WD/2003/3342 dated 06th August, 2020 received from the office of the CDMO(West District), in respect of Shri Sanjay Singh the Anti Quackery Committee noted that Shri Sanjay Singh has been practicing allopathy without holding any requisite medical qualification as enumerated in the Schedules I, II, III of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, entitling him to practice in allopathy and also not being registered with the Delhi Medical Council, in violation of the Section 15(6) of the Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997.

In light of the above, the Anti Quackery Committee, hereby, in exercise of powers conferred under section 10(h) of the Delhi Medical Council, Act, 1997 recommends that Shri Sanjay Singh be directed to stop practicing allopathy, forthwith, and to close down his clinic and Anti Quackery Committee also decided that the police be requested to register a FIR under Section 27 of Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997 alongwith relevant Section of IPC.

3. **Shri Sajid Ali:-** Shri Sajid Ali neither replied nor appeared before the Anti-Quackery Committee in response to Show Cause Notice No.DMC/AQ/F.3-A/SCNs/2/2021/294234 dated 22nd January, 2021. The Anti Quackery Committee noted that notice sent to Shri Sajid Ali returned undelivered in the office of Delhi Medical Council with noting from the Postal Department "No Such Person".

In the light of the above the Anti-Quackery Committee directed that the concerned Chief District Medical Officer (West District) be asked to provide complete and correct address of Shri Sajid Ali to the office of the Delhi Medical Council. Once the same is received, show cause notice again be issued to Shri Sajid Ali.

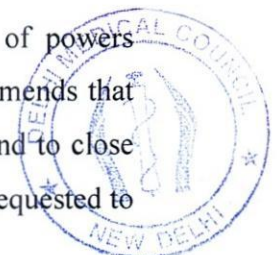


4. **Shri Subhash Chandra Maurya:-** Shri Subhash Chandra Maurya appeared before the Anti-Quackery Committee and submitted a reply. The reply submitted by Shri Subhash Chandra Maurya was found to be unsatisfactory in response to Show Cause Notice No.DMC/AQ/F.3-A/SCNs/2/2021/294235 dated 22nd January, 2021. On examination of the inspection report no. File No: F.20(1)/Antiquackery/DHS/WD/2003/137-140 dated 13th January, 2021 received from the office of the CDMO(West District), in respect of Shri Subhash Chandra Maurya the Anti Quackery Committee noted that Shri Subhash Chandra Maurya has been practicing allopathy without holding any requisite medical qualification as enumerated in the Schedules I, II, III of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, entitling him to practice in allopathy and also not being registered with the Delhi Medical Council, in violation of the Section 15(6) of the Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997.

5. **Shri Chail Bihari Verma :-** Shri Chail Bihari Verma appeared before the Anti-Quackery Committee and submitted a reply. The reply submitted by Shri Chail Bihari Verma was found to be unsatisfactory in response to Show Cause Notice No.DMC/AQ/F.3-A/SCNs/2/2021/294236 dated 22nd January, 2021. On examination of the inspection report no. File No: F.20(1)/Antiquackery/DHS/WD/2003/137-140 dated 13th January, 2021 received from the office of the CDMO(West District), in respect of Shri Chail Bihari Verma the Anti Quackery Committee noted that Shri Chail Bihari Verma has been practicing allopathy without holding any requisite medical qualification as enumerated in the Schedules I, II, III of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, entitling him to practice in allopathy and also not being registered with the Delhi Medical Council, in violation of the Section 15(6) of the Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997.

In light of the above, the Anti Quackery Committee, hereby, in exercise of powers conferred under section 10(h) of the Delhi Medical Council, Act, 1997 recommends that Shri Chail Bihari Verma be directed to stop practicing allopathy, forthwith, and to close down his clinic and Anti Quackery Committee also decided that the police be requested to

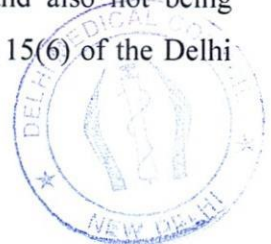


register a FIR under Section 27 of Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997 alongwith relevant Section of IPC.

Biswas the Anti Quackery Committee noted that Shri S.K. Biswas has been practicing allopathy without holding any requisite medical qualification as enumerated in the Schedules I, II, III of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, entitling him to practice in allopathy and also not being registered with the Delhi Medical Council, in violation of the Section 15(6) of the Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997.

In the light of the above the Anti-Quackery Committee directed that the concerned Chief District Medical Officer (North West District) be asked to provide complete and correct address of Shri Mohammad Azmat to the office of the Delhi Medical Council. Once the same is received, show cause notice again be issued to Shri Mohammad Azmat.



10. **Shri Kamal Mandal:-** Shri Kamal Mandal neither replied nor appeared before the Anti-Quackery Committee in response to Show Cause Notice No.DMC/AQ/F.3-A/SCNs/2/2021/294304 dated 27th January, 2021. On examination of the inspection report no. F.No.1(19)/7/2014/A.Q.Insp/DHS/CDMO/CENTRAL/1879 dated 14th January, 2021 received from the office of the CDMO(Central District), in respect of Shri Kamal Mandal the Anti Quackery Committee noted that Shri Kamal Mandal has been practicing allopathy without holding any requisite medical qualification as enumerated in the Schedules I, II, III of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, entitling him to practice in allopathy and also not being registered with the Delhi Medical Council, in violation of the Section 15(6) of the Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997.

In light of the above, the Anti Quackery Committee, hereby, in exercise of powers conferred under section 10(h) of the Delhi Medical Council, Act, 1997 recommends that Shri Kamal Mandal be directed to stop practicing allopathy, forthwith, and to close down his clinic and Anti Quackery Committee also decided that the police be requested to register a FIR under Section 27 of Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997 alongwith relevant Section of IPC.
